



Personal Data Protection - information from GC Broker sp. z o.o.

Pursuant to Art. 13 sec. 1 and sec. 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27th April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (hereinafter referred to as "GDPR") we kindly inform you that:

1. The administrator of your personal data is **GC Broker sp. z o.o.** with its seat in Kielce, al. Solidarności 36, 25-323 Kielce, registered in the Register of Entrepreneurs conducted by the District Court in Kielce, 10th Commercial Department of the National Court Register under the KRS number: 0000549216, NIP: 6572917257, REGON 361049430
2. Your personal data will be processed in order to provide the service related to the submitted inquiry, pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. b GDPR, i.e. processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party or pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. f) GDPR, defense or pursuing possible claims.
3. The recipient of your personal data will only be entities cooperating with the Administrator in the implementation of the service related to the submitted inquiry (entities providing accounting and legal services, entities providing IT services). The data entrusted to them will be transferred to the extent and for the purpose necessary to perform the service.
4. Your personal data will not be transferred outside the European Economic Area.
5. Your personal data will be stored for a period of 05 years from the end of the year in which the service was provided, and longer only if required by law. In addition, the Administrator may store personal data for the purpose of establishing, investigating or defending against claims for the period of limitation of these claims .
6. In connection with the processing of personal data, you have the following rights:
 - 1) the right to access the content of the data (in accordance with Article 15 of the General Data Protection Regulation);
 - 2) the right to rectify data (in accordance with Article 16 of the General Data Protection Regulation);
 - 3) the right to delete data (in accordance with Article 17 of the General Data Protection Regulation);
 - 4) the right to limit data processing (in accordance with Article 18 of the General Data Protection Regulation);
 - 5) the right to data portability (pursuant to Article 20 of the General Data Protection Regulation), the right to object (pursuant to Article 21 of the General Data Protection Regulation);
 - 6) Above rights may be exercised by sending an e-mail to the following address: odo@gcbroker.pl
7. If you recognise that the processing of personal data violates the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
8. Providing your personal data by you is voluntary, but necessary to conclude a contract.
9. Your data will not be profiled.
